WHAT IS HARVEST DAY?

Many of you may not know what Harvest Day is all about. This article will hopefully give you some insight into how/when it got started and what is the purpose. The first of what became an annual event, Harvest Day was held on November 11, 1962. The pastor at that time, Rev. T. H. Williams and a group of nine men got together and came up with a plan to generate funds for the church treasury. At that time most of our congregation were farmers, fishermen, a few government workers and a few Marines. Money was tight so they wanted a way to boost the church treasury. A program in keeping with "The Harvest" being a main theme came into play. A portion of that plan (taken from the original letter) said this:

1. Members of the church who farm plant a plot of land to some crop, from a few rows to an acre or more and cultivate, gather and sell that crop and give the proceeds to the Church Treasury.
2. The Bible teaches us to bring the first fruits of anything & everything the Lord has blessed us with. This makes it possible for each and every member to participate in some way. On the farm & in the home you may have hogs, chickens, cattle, cotton, corn, tobacco, potatoes, fruits, vegetables or anything else that is produced there. The women in the home may contribute canned fruits, needlework or anything that you have that can be sold.
3. For those who do not farm but are engaged in public work, you may bring a cash gift.

This special offering would be in addition to your regular tithes & offerings. The program worked & this has been an ongoing annual event since that first Harvest Day. The plan for donations has changed somewhat but the initial concept is still there. Most members now work outside the home, but all can participate with whatever fits with your own individual budget. The only change is now we have a project each year for something that we all work together for. This year is the purchase of our new live-streaming equipment. Times have changed but Harvest Day is a 59-year tradition. Help us keep that tradition alive. The purpose is the same & we look forward to all of you helping us once again for the ongoing ministry at Bear Creek Baptist Church.
